Temporary Signs

- May be posted up to 75 days before an event.
- Must be removed within 7 days after the end.
- Signs should be placed on or within two feet of the principal structure.
- No permit is needed

Election, contractor, yard sales, and similar signage are most often considered temporary due to their manner of construction, placement, and time posted.

- In the public right-of-way
- On publicly owned property.
- Blocking a road sign or traffic signal.
- On trees, utility poles, public benches, street lights, or street signs.
- Corner lot at the intersection in a triangle 30 feet from the corner.
