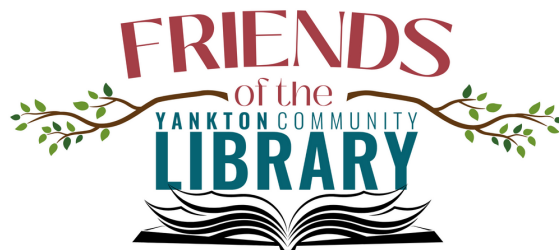

## Friends of the Library

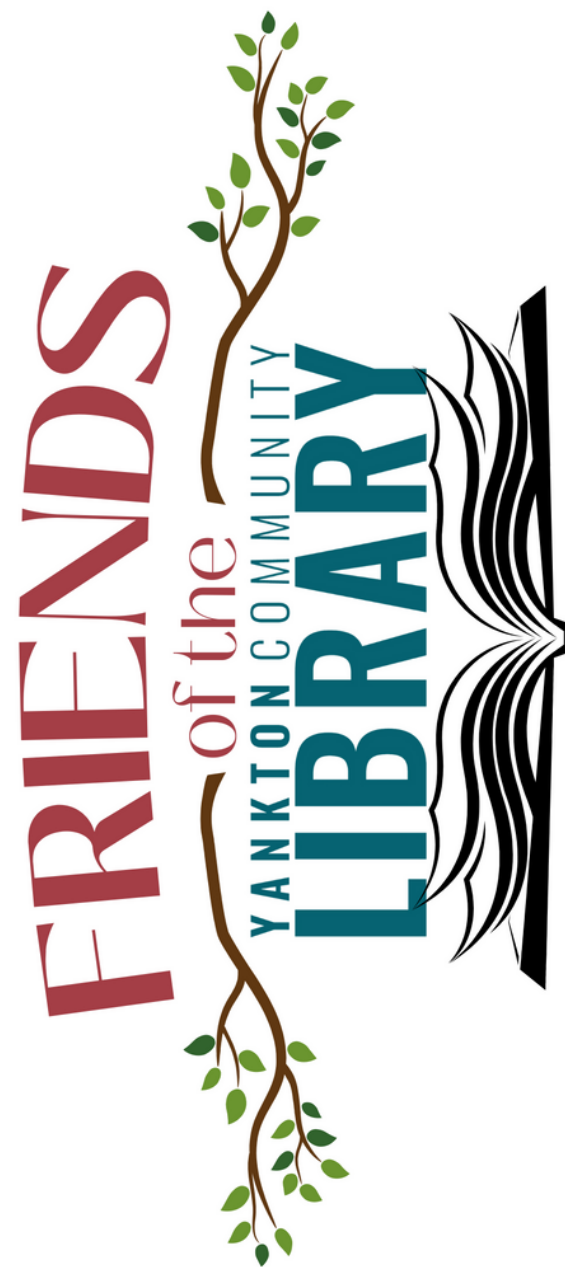
