## CHAMBER OF THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS YANKTON, SOUTH DAKOTA SPECIAL CITY COMMISSION MEETING, 5:30 P.M. DECEMBER 2<sup>ND</sup>, 2020

Budget Workshop Session of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Yankton was called to order by Mayor Johnson.

Commissioner Webber introduced and Mayor Johnson read the title of the Ordinance No. 1044, AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE WEARING OF FACE COVERINGS IN CERTAIN SITUATIONS TO SLOW THE COMMUNITY SPREAD OF THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS CAUSING COVID-19 DISEASE, and set the date of the second reading and public hearing as December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

City Manager, Amy Leon, explained the process of the "introduction" to the ordinance. The second reading and public hearing will take place on December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 5:30 p.m. at the YHS Theater. It was encouraged that citizens submit their comments via e-mail, letter, Facebook or by physically attending the meeting on December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

City Attorney, Ross Den Herder, explained that the ordinance creates a mask mandate, the definition of the mandate, the current exemptions and the abilities to suspend.

Commissioners had some concerns about the language of the ordinance and those will be incorporated for the second reading and public hearing.

Dr. Milroy gave an explanation of why and how the health board supports the proposed ordinance and they recommend its passage.
