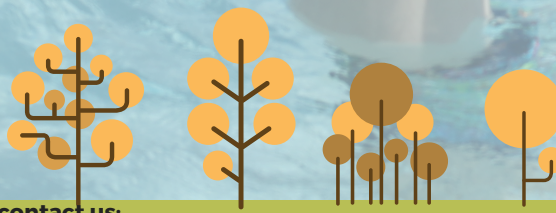

Recreation Program Refunds

Cancelled Programs:

- a full refund will be issued

The City of Yankton reserves the right to cancel or combine any activity or program due to insufficient registration or for any other reason that would prevent the department from providing a quality program. Facility availability or other factors may prohibit classes from being made up, therefore make-up classes are NOT guaranteed.

Requesting a Refund:

- a refund must be requested within 5 business days prior to the start of a program
- refunds are subject to a \$5.00 administrative fee
- Please allow up to 6 weeks for processing

Missed Classes:

- refunds will not be issued for an individual that misses scheduled classes
- there are no make-up classes for individuals that miss scheduled classes

Registration Deadlines

- program registration will remain open up to the listed start date OR until program spots are filled
- late registration may be accepted only if spots are available in the class

Weather Cancellations

Program Spotlight

The City of Yankton Parks and Recreation Department strives to provide fun, high quality, engaging activities that cater to a variety of ages, interests, and abilities. Each year, we continue to add new programs that meet our mission. We hope you check out some of the new programs for Summer of 2024.

NEW- Pickleball for Beginners. This new program is available to kids age 7+. Kids will have an opportunity to learn to play the fastest growing sport in the U.S. This is a lifelong sport that can be played by individuals of any age. A great way for kids to learn a sport they can in turn teach to their families.

NEW- Explore the Hatchery. This camp for youth ages 7+ will take kids “inside” the Gavins Point National Fish Hatchery for a private “behind the scenes” learning experience that will be full of wildlife and fun!

NEW- Explore Yankton’s Dam. This camp for youth ages 7+ will provide an opportunity to learn about and explore Yankton’s very own dam! The Army Corp of Engineers will provide participants with a private learning experience to see the inner workings of the dam and learn about its purpose. A great exploration activity!

NEW- Experience Fishing Camp. This camp has been upgraded for 2024! With the assistance of South Dakota Game Fish and Parks, participants will be taken to Lake Henry in SD GFP fishing boats to learn about water safety, fishing strategies, and reel in a variety of game fish present in our waters. A true fishing experience, out on the water in fishing boats, with the safety and experience of South Dakota Game Fish and Parks to assist.

Along with these new classes, please take some time to view the MANY program offerings that are available this summer. We are confident you will find something just right for everyone in your family.

Red Cross Swim Lessons

Red Cross Swim Lesson Levels (ages 2+)

Students learn elementary water skills and build upon them as they progress through the levels. Levels and descriptions are included below:

Aqua Tots: Little ones learn to have fun in the water, accompanied by a parent or trusted adult. Ages 2-3

Preschool: Swimmers learn beginning water exploration skills and water safety. Ages 4-5

Preschool PLUS: Swimmers are to further develop basic aquatic skills. Children begin to perform these skills at a slightly more advanced level (for example...holding breath for longer lengths of time or swimming longer distances). Ages 4-5

Level I: Introduction to Water Skills- Swimmers continue to build aquatic skills, effective swimming habits and safe practices in and around the water. Ages 6+

Level II: Fundamental Aquatic Skills- Swimmers continue to build aquatic skills, along with alternating arm and leg actions on the front and back, laying the foundation for future strokes. Must have passed Level I to enroll.

Level III: Stroke Development- This course builds on skills from Level II with additional guided practice. Must have passed Level II to enroll.

Level IV: Stroke Development- Develops confidence in strokes learned and improves other aquatic skills. Must have passed Level III to enroll.

Level V: Stroke Refinement- Provides further coordination and refinement of strokes. Must have passed Level IV to enroll.

Level VI: Swimming and Skill Proficiency- Polishes strokes so students swim with ease, efficiency, power and smoothness over greater distances. Level VI concentrates on fitness swimming and lifeguard readiness, preparing students for water safety instructor and lifeguard training classes. Must have passed Level V to enroll.

In the event of inclement weather, all lessons at the Huether Family Aquatics Center will be moved indoors to the Summit Activities Center. Class times will remain the same.

Safety City Play Safe (ages 4-7)

Safety City teaches pedestrian safety, bike safety, gun safety, stranger awareness, poison prevention, water safety and much more! Our goal is to help children recognize dangerous situations and react to them appropriately. Children learn through hands-on activities, songs, role-playing, stories, videos and guest speakers. Camp Programs and Day Trips

Ponca State Park (horseback riding, archery, slingshot, critters and more!) (age 8+)

Travel to Ponca State Park, the eastern gateway of the Missouri National Recreational River, to experience nature at its finest. Participants enjoy an hour-long, supervised horseback ride on the trails and participate in the challenging sport of archery. Participants also take part in the popular “Creepy Critters” program that teaches about critters found in Nebraska and allows campers to touch them if they are brave enough! The day will conclude with going back to the range and shooting slingshots! Parents are required to sign a waiver prior to departure from the SAC for this day camp. **Participants must bring a sack lunch, water and snacks. Dress for the weather, hiking and horseback riding. This day camp will have a bus that transports to and from Ponca State Park from the Summit Activities Center.**

Adventures in Kayaking (age 10+)

Learn the basics of kayaking and safety in this clinic led by National Park Rangers in cooperation with South Dakota State Parks. Participants will learn the basics of kayaking, then set out to paddle and explore Lake Yankton. Park Rangers will teach and discuss wildlife during the excursion. This clinic is held on the south shore of Lake Yankton between the boat ramp and the fishing pier. Participants should bring a water bottle. Dress appropriately for morning conditions on the water and bring sunscreen and insect repellent. Life jackets and kayaks are provided. If inclement weather is forecast, the program will be cancelled by noon on the Thursday before each day camp. **This day camp will have a bus that transports to and from Lake Yankton from the Summit Activities Center.**

Experience Fishing Camp (ages 7+)

A SD Game Fish and Parks Conservation Officer will introduce you to a variety of game fish and the fun that comes with catching them! Learn about fishing regulations, boat safety, tackle, bait and how to identify fish. This camp will transport our young anglers to beautiful Lake Henry to experience a TRUE fishing adventure with a morning “on the water” fishing out of boats with SD GFP conservation officers. Bring along some snacks, water, insect repellent, and sunscreen.
